FileCloud, a secure enterprise file sharing and content collaboration platform, needed to achieve FedRAMP Class D (High) Certification to meet growing federal demand for handling Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI). Rather than pursuing a costly, time-intensive DIY or managed services path, FileCloud partnered with FedHIVE to accelerate their journey, reduce their risk and manage the certification process and agency ATO activities end-to-end.

The Challenge

FileCloud initially explored a DIY path to authorization but quickly encountered the realities of the FedRAMP process:

- Long timeline (18–24+ months)
- High Cost (\$1.5M–\$3M) to achieve agency ATO
- Complex requirements
- Heavy documentation and audit burden
- Need for specialized compliance expertise
- Need for a sponsor and relationships with Authorizing Officials (AOs)

Even with internal cybersecurity experience, the team recognized that:

- The paperwork alone was a major bottleneck
- Interpreting and applying the requirements was challenging
- Building and sustaining an internal compliance team (to achieve FedRAMP certification, agency ATO and sustain continuous monitoring) would divert critical resources

- Production-ready environment established in **less than one week**
- Application deployed in **less than 90 days**
- **FedRAMP certification** package submitted in **under 6 months**
- Agency **ATO Achieved in 90 Days (9 months total end-to-end)**
